We screen thoroughly for a mutually beneficial placement, for your sake as well as the puppy's. Please be honest in answering questions. \*\*Telling us what you think we want to hear will end up with a disappointing placement, creating heartbreak for all, but most of all for the puppy.

We will take back any puppy from our breeding at ANY time for ANY reason, but strive for a correct placement the first time!

Dachshunds are one of the top ten hardest dogs to potty train.  They are not one to learn and then never regress,  Can you provide intense regular potty training in the first few months?  This is beyond what a large dog needs and does require time and A LOT of patience  Adhering to a predictable schedule is needed for success Can you provide this?  Will you be willing to revisit potty training with your dachshund through its lifetime?  *continued refreshers throughout its lifetime are not uncommon.  How will you be housebreaking this puppy?
Will you be potty/puppy pad training or training for outside potty?
(you may have to be "potty trained" FOR them, noticing they haven't gone out for awhile.)

IF YOU'RE INTERESTED IN A SHOW/BREEDING DOG, YOU WILL HAVE TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT THAT THE DOG IS ONLY ALLOWED TO BE BRED IF APPROVED BY THE BREEDERS OF YOUR PUPPY AND THAT IT HAS A CHAMPION TITLE BEFORE IT'S BRED unless agreed ahead of time in writing.

ALL PUPPIES WILL CARRY THE PLATINUM TITLE IN ITS REGISTRATION NAME, SHOW OR COMPANION.

WE STRIVE FOR HEALTHY, PROVEN DACHSHUNDS THAT CONFORM TO THE STANDARD.

<u>ALL PUPPIES /DOG WILL BE SOLD ON A CO-OWNERSHIP UNLESS NOTED AHEAD, ALL MICROCHIPS WILL HAVE BREEDER AS A SECONDARY CONTACT. THIS IS DONE TO ENSURE THAT SHOULD SOMETHING HAPPEN TO THE PRIMARY OWNER. OR IF THE DOG IS IN A SHELTER SITUATION THAT</u>
